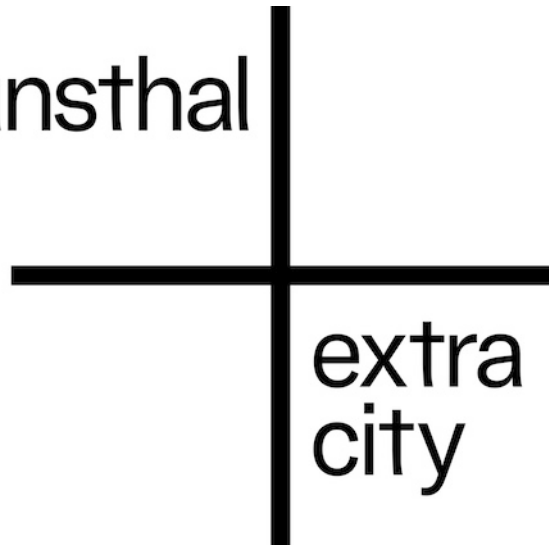

Over the past years, Kunsthall Extra City set out an ambitious artistic programme, embedded in the urban fabric.
